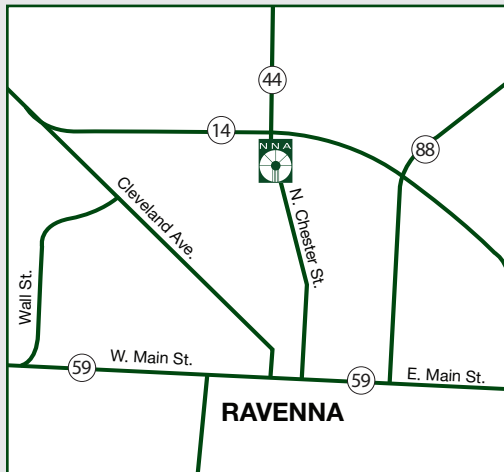

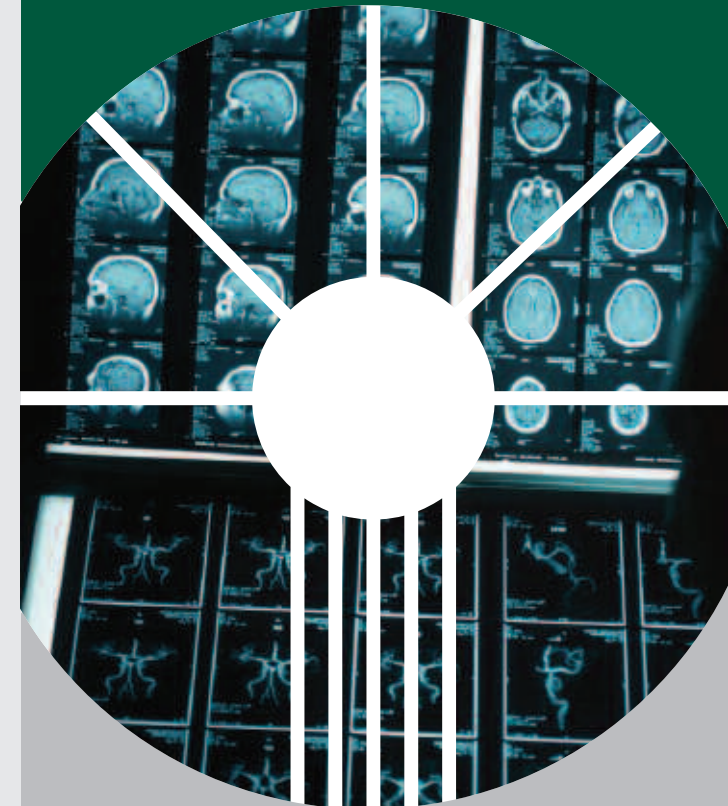

Neurodiagnostic testing lab

Neurodiagnostic consults by our physicians ensure the most appropriate and effective tests are ordered. Or, the referring physician may directly order tests.

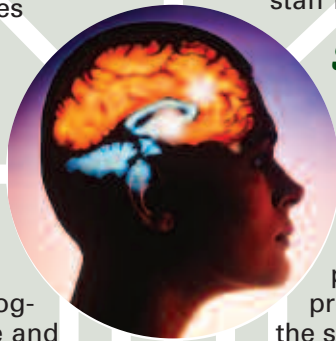
Testing with our state-of-the-art equipment is scheduled within one week. Timely reports are generated by our staff for the referring physician.

Sleep disorders – diagnosis and treatment
